Jean-François Saucier was elected to the Caisse populaire Trois Rives' Board of Directors in 2014, first as vice-chair of the Audit Committee and subsequently as vice-chair of the Board. He was elected to the Fédération des caisses populaires acadiennes' Board of Directors in 2015, as the northwest area representative, where he served on both the Executive Committee and the Audit Committee. When his terms as a director came to an end in July 2016, following the collective bridging and creation of UNI Financial Cooperation, Mr. Saucier took on the position of vice-chair of the Madawaska Cooperative Committee. In 2018, he was elected to a three-year term on the UNI Financial Cooperation's Board of Directors as representative for the northwest area.

After starting his career in 2004 as an auditor and management advisor at LeBlanc Nadeau Bujold, he went on to work as an account manager at UNI's Edmundston Financial Business Centre from 2008 to 2014. Since 2014, he was appointed professor of accounting and taxation at the Université de Moncton, Edmundston Campus (UMCE).

Mr. Saucier holds a master's degree in business administration (concentration in accounting science with a profile in financial accounting) from the Université de Sherbrooke, a Bachelor of Business Administration (concentration in accounting) from the Université de Moncton and a certificate in financial planning from Laurentian University. He is a member of the Quebec CPA Order, CPA New Brunswick and the Canadian Ski Instructors' Alliance.

Mr. Saucier is very involved in his community, serving as treasurer of the Salon du livre d'Edmundston, board member of Edmundston Events, member of the Small Business Week organizing committee and co-chair of the Evolution Fundraising Campaign of the Université de Moncton, Edmundston campus. He has also been organizing the Community Volunteer Income Tax Program in Edmundston since 2011. He was co-treasurer of the fundraising campaign for Edmundston's Community Amphitheatre, treasurer of the Governor General's Canadian Leadership Conference and member of the Secrétariat à la jeunesse in Edmundston.
